Activities will include:



TIPS TO ENJOY THE ROONEY'S 5K RACE

For the runners and walkers:

When first starting your 5K training or any new sports activity, check with your doctor first. You should be able to walk at a 15 minutes per mile brisk pace for 30 minutes. If you cannot, you should build your walking distance first. If you are a runner, gradually add running to your regimen by slowly adding a combination of fast walking and running. The recommended time for the walk/run is two minutes of running followed by four minutes of walking for 30 minutes. You can gradually increase the running while decreasing the walking until you can run for 30 consecutive minutes.

For the most dedicated athletic supporters:

The first and most important tool of the trade is a good alarm clock since there is no way you would get out of bed at seven o'clock on a Saturday morning to run around in your neighborhood much less get in your car and drive to someone else's neighborhood to cheer on your "oh so in-shape" friends or relatives. The second item of necessity is a good lightweight camping chair complete with cup holders and foot and headrests like the Coleman Lazy One model which are in stock at your local Sears or Target stores. The third and most critical item is a fully charged cell phone for the occasional Facebooking, Twittering, or the finish line photo with your runner or walker. The premium seats are the ones closest to the Finish Line though you must do some neck stretches for a few minutes prior to getting in position since the Start/Finish line may be one in the same and there are nuances to gracefully turning your chair around. Remember to stay loose and relax since you need all your energy for the real workout and closer event following the Run/Walk...the traditional Irish Breakfast AND Celebrate Westgate Festival at the Westgate Community Center!!!

FLOOD INSURANCE RATES LIKELY TO INCREASE AFTER APRIL 1

Starting on April 1, 2015, the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) will start adopting new Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM). As a result, flood insurance rates and other charges will be revised (most likely increased) for most new and many existing policies.

Flood maps inform communities about the local flood risk and help set minimum floodplain standards for communities to build safely. They determine the cost of flood insurance, which helps property owners to financially protect themselves against flooding. The lower the degree of risk, the lower the flood insurance premium will be.

The goal of this 2014 congressionally mandated legislation is to stabilize the National Flood Insurance Program by raising rates on certain classes of property to provide coverage that reflects the true flood risk faced by a community. The change will ultimately decrease the amount of money that FEMA would spend after an actual flood.

Currently, a lot of properties are paying subsidized insurance rates. After April 1, 2015 the subsidized rates will be phased out and most property owners will be responsible to pay the full value of their insurance premiums. The increase will not happen at once. Premiums will transition from the current premium to the new premium over 5 years in 20% increments.

Owner occupied homes which have a valid insurance policy before April 1, 2015 may benefit from a grandfathering lower-cost flood insurance rating option. Those who don't have flood insurance will pay a higher rate and higher surcharges in order to acquire new insurance policies for their property.
