WESTGATE GREENMARKET EXPRESS TO BEGIN NEW SEASON

The Westgate Greenmarket Express will begin this season on Saturday, November 8, 2014.

The cart will run from 9:00 a.m to 2:00 p.m. every Saturday Morning thru May.

We are fortunate to have our vegetables provided by Farming Systems Research (Green Cay Farms) and Solace International. The vegetables are grown locally, picked on Friday, and sold on the cart on Saturday.

Unlike grocery store vegetables, these are fresh picked right from the farm.

This season we will also have a registered dietitian on board one Saturday a month. Brittannie Stanley Chester will create a newsletter containing recipes using the vegetables on the cart. She will also talk to you about healthy portions and explain how eating t

SEMINOLE AND OSCEOLA BRIDGES TO BE REPLACED

The bridges crossing the Lake Worth Drainage District's LWDD L-2 Canal at Seminole Boulevard and Osceola Drive have reached their life expectancy. Palm Beach County Engineering Department has hired a contractor to replace both bridges. Construction will begin in November 2014 and will last three to four months ending in February 2015.

The Seminole Boulevard Bridge improvements will be done first. Osceola Boulevard Bridge will stay open until the new Seminole Boulevard vehicular crossing is completed and opened. The Osceola Bridge will be replaced with a pedestrian crossing. While the Osceola Bridge is under construction, all vehicular traffic to and from Belvedere homes will go through the new Seminole crossing and the Wabasso Drive crossing.

Both the School District and Fire Rescue are aware of the bridge replacement project and have stated that the project will not interfere with their operation.

PROPERTY MATTERS With Anne M. Gannon, Constitutional Tax Collector, Palm Beach County

Save Money on Property Taxes

Here are options that could help you save on your property tax bill:

Pay early.

2014 Property taxes are payable November 1, 2014-March 31, 2015. You can take advantage of our early payment discounts.

November: 4% discount
December: 3% discount
January: 2% discount
February: 1% discount
March: no discount

Pay in smaller installments instead of one lump sum.

The Installment Payment Plan divides your property taxes into four payments:

June, September, December, and March. If you use this plan, you receive a discount slightly under 4%. For more information and to sign up for the 2015 property tax season, visit pbctax.com. Applications must be received by 5 p.m. April 30, 2015.

Dispute your property tax valuation.

Taxpayers may file a petition with the Value Adjustment Board to challenge the Property Appraiser's assessment, classification, or exemption status. Once a petition is filed, the taxpayer must pay at least 75% of the Ad-Valorem taxes and 100% of the Non-Ad Valorem taxes before April 1.

To ePay 2014 property taxes, visit the Online Search & Payment Center at pbctax.com. Payments will be accepted online beginning November 1.

Property taxes fund everything from roads to schools and law enforcement to libraries.
